The final fee, which will include food, lodging, conference fees, transportation fees

and other contingent merchandise has been estimated at approximately \$650 and should be officially announced by August 2011. Also, if you preregister by Fall Ordeal, you will receive one free additional NOAC 2012 lodge contingent flap over and above what other contingent members receive.
