## Breaking News!

On June 7th, 2019, the national OA committee approved several significant policy changes. The most relevant of these changes to general membership is the reduced waiting period for Brotherhood membership from ten (10) to six (6) months.

- Brotherhood Requirements: Effective immediately, the waiting period between induction and eligibility for Brotherhood membership has been reduced to six (6) months. All other requirements are unchanged.
