The National Order of the Arrow Conference, or NOAC for short, is a week-long gathering of members of the Order of the Arrow, typically held every other year in late July to early August on a college campus. Next year, NOAC will be held from July 25-30, 2022 at the University of Tennessee at Knoxville which is only a few hours away from Middle Tennessee! More than 8,000 Arrowmen from all 50 states will attend NOAC, making it the largest Scouting event to take place in 2022. NOAC consists of both training and fellowship and is the pinnacle event in the Order of the Arrow!



Most Arrowmen attend NOAC as a delegate, which is a participant attending with their lodge contingent. As a delegate, NOAC offers many activities and programs, including training, shows, recreation, and more!

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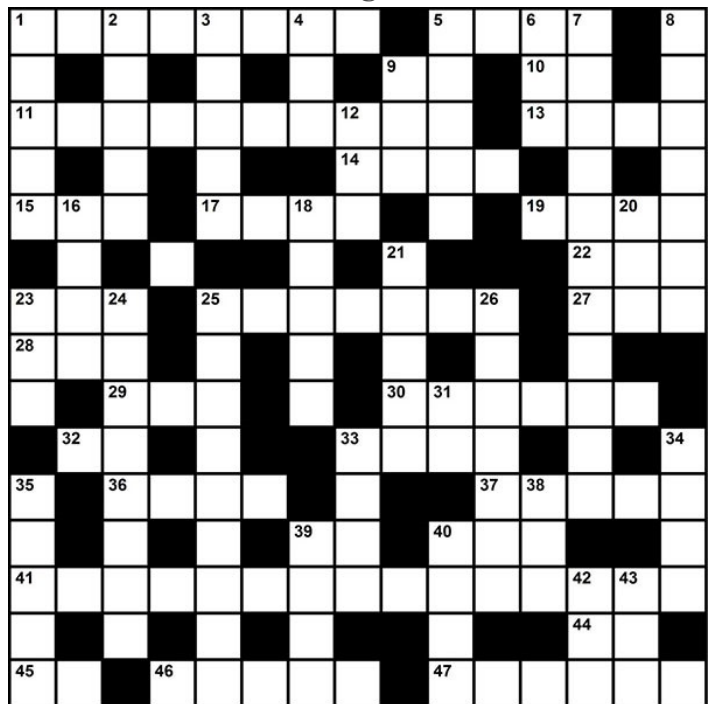
